WINE LIST (BY THE BOTTLE)

Non Alcoholic Wines

1. **Bodegas Torres Natureo 0.0% Sparkling, Semi-Seco (De-Alcoholised)** \$55
 - *Muscat*
 - *Tasting Notes: Beautiful golden yellow color and a nice subtle bubble. The full notes of tropical fruit, vanilla and apricots and the slightly sweet aftertaste.*

2. **Bodegas Torres Natureo 0.0% White Muscat (De-Alcoholised)** \$55
 - *Muscat*
 - *Tasting Notes: A pale yellow wine which offers seductive aromas of white flowers and fresh fruit (quince, Guyot pear). The palate is warm, silky and very flavourful.*

3. **Bodegas Torres Natureo 0.0% Garnacha-Syrah (De-Alcoholised)** \$55
 - *Garnacha Syrah Blend*
 - *Tasting Notes: Enjoy a lovely cherry-red wine, with aromas of pomegranate and currant, and hints of oak-imparted vanilla and toast. Round, balanced and truly clean on the palate with soft tannins and delicate acidity.*

SPARKLING WINES

1. **Casa Gheller Prosecco DOC Spumante Brut (11%)** \$70
 - 100% Glera
 - *Tasting Notes: It has a pale straw yellow color, fine and persistent perlage; the bouquet is fruity and floral with notes of ripe golden apple and small mountain flowers. The taste is dry, fresh and savory with a fruity and harmonious aftertaste.*

2. **Domaine Rolet - Cremant du Jura 'Coeur de Chardonnay' Brut - 2018 (12%)** \$110
 - 100% Chardonnay
 - *Tasting Notes: A golden yellow robe with silver hues. Limpid, clean and fine, delicate bubbles. Complex and ample aromas of apple and lemons. Lively on the palate with hint of freshness and soft finish of citrus notes. A Crémant full of purity with subtle final note.*

CHAMPAGNES

1. **Champagne Delamotte - Blanc de Blancs – NV** \$170
 - 100% Chardonnay
 - *Tasting Notes: This wine offer classy bouquet of crisp green apple, citrus oil, brioche, toasted nuts and dried white flowers. On the palate, the wine is medium to full-bodied, fine-boned and elegant, with a crisp but charming core of fruit, lively acids and a precise, saline finish.*

2. **Champagne Augustin Cuvée Cxci Terre Blanc De Noir Brut** \$180
 - 100% Pinot Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: A good, light-intensity champagne that plays in two dimensions interweaving fruit and yeast. Lemon in color, this wine has light lees aromas that do not overwhelm and that ride below the sparkling wine's fruit character. On the palate the dry, medium-bodied champagne has soft layers of lemon citrus running throughout.*

3. **Krug Grande Cuvée 169ème Édition champagne** \$450
 - 43% Pinot Noir, 35% Chardonnay and 22% Meunier
 - *Tasting Notes: A light golden colour and fine, vivacious bubbles, holding a promise of pleasure. Aromas of flowers in bloom, ripe, dried and citrus fruits, as well as marzipan and gingerbread. Flavours of hazelnut, nougat, barley sugar, jellied and citrus fruits, almonds, brioche and honey.*

SAKES

- 1. Hanagaki Junmai Nigori (Fukui, 720ml)** \$70
 - 14%, Polishing 65%, SMV -20
 - *Tasting Notes: Aromas of rice, porridge and coconut cream with a fruity, textured palate. A good harmony of acidity, sweetness and umami, and along, lingering finish.*

- 2. Masumi (S) Junmai Gingyo Summer Suzumi Sake (Nagano, 720ml)** \$100
 - 14%, Polishing 55%, SMV unpublished
 - *Tasting Notes: Bright acidity that highlights the freshness of summer food. Suzumi sake mean the liquid image of the cool breeze that refreshes the wildflowers of Masumi's highland home each summer. It is brewed with rarely used white koji to create a bright citric acidity*
Rice: Miyamanishiki, Hitogokochi (Nagano)Yeast: Masumi No.7

- 3. Kamoshibito Kuheiji Omachi Sauvage Junmai Daiginjo (Aichi, 720ml)** \$120
 - 16%, Polishing 50%, SMV unpublished
 - *Tasting Notes: Through their renowned principles of producing sake with purer, sharper flavour profiles similar to French white wine, Kuheiji delivers an astoundingly fresh and full-bodied palate with the rich, well-balanced qualities of this Sauvage junmai daiginjo. Appropriately named for the potent, raw flavours Kuheiji draws from their own harvests of native Omachi sake rice, polishing these plump rice grains to 50% is all that's needed to unlock their rich fruity notes and invigorating herbal aromas, while producing a light sake with a classic, umami mouthfeel..*

WHITE WINES (Vintage Subject to Change)

1. **La Mora Vermentino di Toscana DOC 2022 (Maremma Tuscany, 12.5%)** \$70
 - Vermentino 100%
 - Tasting Notes: Fresh & fragrant with aromas of stone fruit & pineapple with bright, succulent flavors of white peach, ripe pear & lime zest. It carries hints of succulent tropical fruits, mature pulp & a fresh & fragrant style, with a pleasant minerality
2. **Omina Romana - Bianco Hermes Diactors II IGT 2021 (Lazio, 13.5%)** \$100
 - 62% Viognier, 13% Incrocio Manzoni, 13% Petit Manseng, 12% Chardonnay
 - Tasting Notes: Fruit forward, warm apricots, tropical fruits like guava and papaya, citrus, intense jasmine scent, calendula and white nougat. Creamy texture, dense structure, fresh fruit and acidity, medium-bodied, dry and fruit driven finish
3. **Domaine Vincent Wengier Bourgogne Chardonnay 2021 (Bourgogne, 12.5%)** \$100
 - Chardonnay 100%
 - Tasting Notes: The 2021 Domaine Vincent Wengier has, first and foremost, ripping acidity. It gathers the wine perfectly and delivers a brilliant, enduring finish. Taste green apple, zesty lime, whole lemon, and a bit of briny maritime salinity on the back-palate. Some lees work gives it real breadth and presence on the palate.
4. **Domaine Regis Jouan – Sancerre 2022 (Upper Loire Valley, 12.5%)** \$100
 - Sauvignon Blanc 100%
 - Tasting Notes: Sophisticated & stylish, the Jouan has all the classic lemon, citrus & star-fruit notes as well as a heavenly hint of flowers. With a racy, white grapefruit palate & tart, dry lemon on the finish
5. **El Enemigo Chardonnay 2020 (Mendoza, 13.5%)** \$150
 - Chardonnay 100%
 - Tasting Notes: Light golden center with silver streaks throughout the glass. Ripe nectarine, Fuji apple, lemon meringue, and wet-stone aromas intermingle. Jasmine and lilac, along with wet minerals and salted citrus peel, make their way to the palate. The mouthfeel is glorious and polished, showing beautiful poise and elegance. The small amount of Chardonnay that rested under flor adds depth, but the wine also displays plenty of energy and buoyancy. Truly unique.
6. **Faiveley Mercurey Blanc Clos Rochette Monopole 2021 (Bourgogne, 13%)** \$160
 - Chardonnay 100%
 - Tasting Notes: This wine reveals exceptionally complex aromas and a fresh nose offering white flowers and spices. The lively attack gives way to a smooth, oily palate thanks to its oak ageing. The flavours and aromas combine harmoniously resulting in a beautifully elegant wine.
7. **Domaine J.M. Boillot Montagny Premier Cru 2019 (Cote Chalonnaise, 13%)** \$180
 - Chardonnay 100%
 - Tasting Notes: This wine has juicy yellow color with a slight greenish tint. Aroma of invigorating, juicy lemon flavor and perfectly set off by baking in a bouquet of wine oak notes. Fine structure and good fresh acidity and minerality. On the palate there are shades of ripe pears, peaches, apples and light creamy nuances, rolling along with fleshy oak notes in the long aftertaste.

ROSE (Vintage Subject to Change)

1. **Omina Romana - Merlot Rosato IGT 2021 (Lazio, 13.5%)** \$100
 - 100% Merlot
 - *Tasting Notes: Bright light pink with notes of pink grapefruit, exotic fruits and an elegant touch of floral. Impresses with the perfect combination of freshness and creaminess.*

2. **Frank Cornelissen SUSUCARU® Rosato 2020 (Sicilia, 11.5%)** \$110
 - *Malvasia, Moscadella, Cattaratto, Nerello Mascalese*
 - *Tasting Notes: Rosè (Rosato) "Susucaru" is a blend of old grapes grown on Etna. Skin contact maceration for texture and territorial identity, malolactic fermentation fully finished for density, fluidity and stability. Not only a refreshing summer wine from a blend of Malvasia, Moscadella, Insolia and Nerello Mascalese, as this is a "rosé" which can also be regarded as a light red, like a "Jura" wine, pairing well with a wide variety of dishes.*

RED WINES from FRANCE (Vintage Subject to Change)

- 1. Cotes Catalanes - Infiniment de l'Ou 2016 (Languedoc-Roussillon, 14%)** \$150
 - 100% Syrah
 - *Tasting Notes: Vinified & aged in barrel, its deep black/purple color is followed by a fabulous bouquet of cassis, smoked herbs, graphite & cured meats. Ripe, sexy, unctuous & layered, with moderate acidity & sweet tannin*

- 2. Chateau La Tour de Mons - Margaux red 2014 (Bordeaux, 14%)** \$160
 - 55% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot.
 - *Tasting Notes: A classic wine, elegant and pure and fully respectful of this great terroir of Margaux. Matures for 12 months in French oak barrels. With an intense colour, the wine displays a very broad aromatic range. Elegant and distinguished. This vintage, with its great balance between fruit and tannins. It is a ripe wine full of black fruit and with the bright acidity of the vintage.*

- 3. Château La Fleur Peyrabon Pauillac 2017 (Bordeaux, 13%)** \$150
 - 68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 7% Petit Verdot
 - *Tasting Notes: Dense and expressive nose with aromas of black fruit (burlat cherry, blackcurrant) and a pleasant freshness. Frank acidity in the mouth, followed by a structured and elegant mid-palate, fleshy tannins.*

- 4. Domaine Boucabeille Les Orris Rouge 2015 (Côtes du Roussillon, 14%)** \$150
 - 70% Syrah, 30% Grenache Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: Deep purple/ ruby colour with impeccably clean notes of black raspberries and cassis intermixed with notions of new leather, pepper and scrub bush. Full bodies, elegant and seamless, with beautiful and fine tannins.*

- 5. Faiveley Mercurey Rouge Vieilles Vignes 2021 (Bourgogne, 13%)** \$160
 - 100% Pinot Noir
 - *Tasting Notes: Our "vieillesvignes" (oldvines) are over thirty years old and produce an exceptionally aromatic wine that offers a true reflection of its Mercurey terroirs. The palate reveals a smooth, fruity attack and evolves towards notes of ripe red berries and a touch of vanilla. An intensely aromatic wine with a delicate structure and silky smooth tannins that will win over wine experts and amateurs alike.*

- 6. Château Galius Saint-Emilion Grand Cru 2019 (Bordeaux, 13%)** \$140
 - 85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Franc
 - *Tasting Notes: This Grand Cru Saint-Emilion is rich and ripe and at a magical point in its life, drinking very, very well. It's a stunning example of how Bordeaux terroir shines through the merlot grape in all its generosity and finesse, with a touch of cab franc (15%) adding fresh notes to all that fruit. Expect an abundance of plums, vanilla and milk chocolate. Forest floor and herbal undergrowth are hidden softly underneath - sage and oregano, tobacco leaf. Spice ekes in around my edges, with broad, silky tannin riding on a backbone of bright acidity and keen structure.*

RED WINES from ITALY (Vintage Subject to Change)

1. **La Marchesana, Primitivo IGT 2021 (Puglia 14%)** \$70
 - Primitivo 100%
 - Tasting Notes: The aromas of cherry compote & red groats pour out of the glass. In the background the smoky notes of bacon & black olive. Slight hint of chocolate, vanilla & sage, on the palate completed by gentle tannins & a mild acidity

2. **Omina Romana - Rosso "Diana Nemorensis I" IGT 2013 (Lazio, 13.5%)** \$120
 - Merlot 50%, Cabernet Sauvignon 30%, Cabernet Franc 20%
 - Tasting Notes: Bright, medium ruby colour. Intense and fruit forward, ripe red plum, blackcurrant, cranberry, sweet spiciness, hints of vanilla, cloves, dark chocolate. Medium bodied, dry, juicy, accessible tannins and with a delicious round texture

3. **Villa Cerna Chianti Classico DCG Riserva 2018 (Tuscany, 14%)** \$120
 - Sangiovese 95%, Colorino 5%
 - Tasting Notes: Floral aromas with harmony balance between acidity, tannins and alcohol

4. **Corte Medicea Toscana Rosso Aros 2019 (Tuscany, 13.5%)** \$120
 - Sangiovese 50%, Cabernet Sauvignon 50%
 - Tasting Notes: This half/half sangiovese cabernet blend typifies Toscana IGT (aka Supertuscan), with all the cherries and sandy tannins you'd expect, plus structure and blackcurrants from cabernet and a few good licks of chocolate and vanilla from judicious oak use. Full-bodied and harmonic, structured with enticing, and velvet softness. Elegant final sensation.

5. **Villa Matta Amarone della Valpolicella DCG 2020 (Veneto, 14.5%)** \$140
 - 70% corvina veronese, 20% rondinella, 5% molinara, 5% others
 - Tasting Notes: An opulent wine of the classic Verona tradition. Red ruby color with garnet highlights. Very fruity with hints of cherry, black cherry and wild berry fruit. The mouth has a good structure with juicy fruit derived from the maceration on skins of Amarone. The tannin is soft and velvety.

6. **Massimo Rattalino Trentaquattro34 Barolo DCG 2015 (Piemonte, 14.5%)** \$180
 - 100% Nebbiolo
 - Tasting Notes: It is a powerful, elegant and austere wine with an intense garnet colour. When young, it gives off elegant aromas of roses, violets and rhubarb which, with age, evolve into notes of spice, black pepper and truffle. On the mouth, it is strong yet balanced with a very long finish

7. **Tenuta Di Sesta Brunello di Montalcino DCG 2018 (Toscana, 14.5%)** \$150
 - 100% Sangiovese (Grosso)
 - Tasting Notes: Colour ruby red towards garnet with ageing. Scent intense, broad bouquet, elegant, rich in scents of mellow red fruits, spicy in notes of licorice and tobacco. Taste dry, warm, soft with velvet tannins, balanced, very intense, very persistent and elegant

8. Querciabella Turpino Toscana IGT 2017 (Toscana, 14.5%) \$150

- *40% Cabernet Franc, 40% Syrah, 20% Merlot*
- *Tasting Notes: Black cherry, pine, menthol, licorice and chocolate develop nicely over time. The 2017 embodies the house style at Querciabella these days nicely. The wine is rich and deep, but not at all overdone.*

9. Villa Mongalli, Sagrantino di Montefalco DOCG 2014 (Umbria, 15.5%) \$150

- *100% Sagrantino*
- *Tasting Notes: Aged in French high quality oak barrels and refined at last for one year in bottle it appears of intense red ruby colour, with tendency to garnet red colour, with fruity parfum and smell of spices and vanilla, harmonious and properly tannic. This elegant and strong wine is a fruit of the land, rich in skeleton and micro elements*

10. Rubinelli Vajol Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2013 (Veneto, 16%) \$180

- *Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella, Molinara, Oseleta*
- *Tasting Notes: Medium garnet colour. Straight out of the glass, concentrated aroma of dried strawberry, supported by notes of espresso, dark chocolate, cinnamon, raspberry jam as well as balsamic vinegar and sour dark cherry. This Amarone is perfectly dry, with refined tannins, a high level of alcohol and a full body. Long elegant finish.*

RED WINE from OTHERS (Vintage Subject to Change)

1. **El Enemigo Malbec 2019 (Mendoza 13.5%)** \$150
 - 90% Malbec, 8% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot
 - *Tasting Notes: On the nose, this Malbec has floral scents of violets and lavender as well as ripe blackberries and spice from the small percentage of Petit Verdot. The wine is full-bodied with well integrated tannins and high acidity.*

2. **Izway Wines Bruce Shiraz 2020 (Barossa Valley 14.8%)** \$160
 - 100% Shiraz
 - *Tasting Notes: Dark and powerful, soulful and brooding, the 2020 Bruce is a bold Barossa Shiraz and one that will excite those that yearn for the classic styles. The aromatics impose themselves on the room as soon as they hit the glass, with cassis, olive tapenade and dark chocolate dominating hints of sage. The texture is rich but assured, with the plush characteristics held firm by the now conventional addition of Eden Valley Shiraz (just 7.5% for this vintage).*

3. **MAS MARTINET BRU 2019 (Priorat 14%)** \$120
 - 28% Garnacha, 26% Syrah, 23% Cariñena, 16% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Sauvignon
 - *Tasting Notes: Saturated ruby. A highly perfumed, smoke- and spice-accented bouquet evokes primary cherry and blueberry scents, along with candied licorice and potpourri nuances. Seamless and impressively concentrated, offering appealingly sweet dark berry, cherry cola and floral pastille flavors that meld richness and energy. Dusty tannins build steadily on a long, gently chewy finish that leaves cherry liqueur and lavender notes behind.*
