Champagne

- 1. Charles Collin Champagne Cuvee Charles Brut (Champagne, 12%)** **\$138**
 - 80% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Noir (Vivino Rating: 4.0)
 - Dominated by the freshness of citrus fruits, grapefruit and mandarin, the nose combines vivacity and complexity. The palate is invigorating and crisp. It opens up and lingers on a complex finish, a blend of honey and spice flavors.
- 2. Champagne Charles collin cuvée charles blanc de blancs 2012 (Champagne, 12%)** **\$180**
 - Chardonnay 100% (Vivino Rating: N/A)
 - The Chardonnay opens on the palate with notes of white fruit, pear, and apple. The vibrancy of the vintage shines through in a refreshingly crisp finish. It's a testament to a beautiful harvest, a great vintage.
- 3. Champagne Augustin Cuvée Ccxc Terre Blanc De Noir Brut (Champagne, 12%)** **\$180**
 - 100% Pinot Noir (Vivino Rating: 4.3)
 - A good, light-intensity champagne that plays in two dimensions interweaving fruit and yeast. Lemon in color, this wine has light lees aromas that do not overwhelm and that ride below the sparkling wine's fruit character. On the palate the dry, medium-bodied champagne has soft layers of lemon citrus running throughout

Sparkling Wines

- 4. Bottega Prosecco Millesimato Brut 2025 (Veneto, 11%)** **\$68**
 - Glera 100%
 - Straw yellow, clear, with a fine and very persistent perlage. Fruity, flowery, scents of Golden apple and exotic fruit. Fragrant, fresh, well balanced.
- 5. Palazzo di Varignana Villa Amagioia Brut Blanc de Noir (Emilia-Romagna, 12.5%)** **\$98**
 - 100% Pinot Nero
 - Golden yellow color with rose gold hues; fine and dense perlage. Citrus notes with the aroma of white flowers. Full in the palate with pleasant fruity notes accompanied by a salinity that runs throughout the length of the taste. Fresh and flavorful, the citrus notes reappear with blue clay mineral notes.
- 6. Genevieve Blanc de Blancs RD 2013 (Western Cape, 12.5%)** **\$138**
 - Chardonnay 100% (Vivino Rating: 4.2)
 - Only 3000 bottles produced. 2013 vintage was healthy with high quality fruit, and harvest took place over a short, later period. This MCC was matured on the lees for 10 years, recently disgorged June 2023. This vintage dazzles with complex fruit and brioche notes which play intricately with each other. Fruit notes of apple and orange citrus like tangerine peak through beautiful mineral core and restrained creaminess, with hints of savory spice.

White Wine (Vintage Subject to Change)

- 7. Malas Companias Blanco 2022 (Spain, 12.5%)** **\$68**
- *Albarino, Verdejo, Macabeo*
 - *Peachy notes one expects from an Albarino, with a citrus buzz from the Verdejo with a touch of the herbal and creamy notes from the Macabeo.*
- 8. La Mora Vermentino di Toscana DOC 2022 (Maremma Tuscany, 12.5%)** **\$68**
- *Vermentino 100%*
 - *Fresh & fragrant with aromas of stone fruit & pineapple with bright, succulent flavors of white peach, ripe pear & lime zest. It carries hints of succulent tropical fruits, mature pulp & a fresh & fragrant style, with a pleasant minerality*
- 9. Michele Satta Costa Di Giulia Bolgheri Bianco 2024 (Toscana, 13.5%)** **\$98**
- *60% Vermentino, 40% Savignon (Vivino Rating: 4.0)*
 - *The nose swirls with cool, delicate, saline aromas of crushed rocks, white flowers, white peach and lemon. Lemons, limes and more of that just-ripe peach element define the palate, while tree fruit and nuts join in before a finish of nutty, salty, bitter almond skin.*
- 10. Susanna Balbo Signature Barrel Fermented Torrontes (Mendoza, 13.5%)** **\$118**
- *100% Torrontés*
 - *A golden colored Torrontés with bright reflections. The nose is fragrant and complex, with hints of tropical fruits (especially lychee), citrus notes (such as lemon peel) and delicate floral aromas. The mouth is harmonious, with a balanced acidity that goes with some intense fruit flavors. It has a good, round body and a silky texture.*
- 11. Domaine Jean-Paul Balland – Sancerre 2023 (Upper Loire Valley, 12.5%)** **\$118**
- *Chardonnay 100% (Vivino Rating: 4.1)*
 - *Sweet spot Outstanding. Here the wood treatment is more subtle on the very pretty and more floral-suffused nose of citrus, anise and white orchard fruit scents. There is a finer texture to the punchier medium weight flavors that culminate in a bone-dry, balanced and even more persistent finale. The underlying tension is palpable and overall, this chiseled effort is very good and a wine that should amply repay mid-term keeping*
- 12. Domaine Laroche Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons Vieilles Vignes 2022 (Burgundy, 12.5%)** **\$150**
- *100% Chardonnay*
 - *There is a velvety character in this wine that comes from the sunny character of the vineyard. Perfectly ripe Chardonnay grapes grown on old vines give Vaillons a typical oriental spice overtone. On the palate it offers intensity but never lacks the elegance of the best premier crus of Chablis.*

Red Wine From Italy (Vintage Subject to Change)

- 13. La Marchesana, Primitivo IGT 2024 (Puglia 14%)** **\$70**
- *Primitivo 100%*
 - *The aromas of cherry compote & red groats pour out of the glass. In the background the smoky notes of bacon & black olive. Slight hint of chocolate, vanilla & sage, on the palate completed by gentle tannins & a mild acidity*
- 14. Michele Satta Bolgheri Rosso 2023 (Toscana, 13.5%)** **\$108**
- *Sangiovese 30%, Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 20% Syrah 10%, Teroldego 10% (Vivino Rating: 3.9)*
 - *The nose sparkles with gently energetic aromas of blackberry tea, pomegranate syrup, cola and soil, and the palate has a similar feel, as flavors of vanilla, black cherry and a chocolatey cola recall and old-fashioned ice cream float, but savory overtones of pepper and more soil provide a practiced balance.*
- 15. Corte Medicea Toscana Rosso Aros 2019 (Toscana, 13.5%)** **\$108**
- *Sangiovese 50%, Cabernet Sauvignon 50%*
 - *This half/half Sangiovese cabernet blend typefies Toscana IGT (aka Supertuscan), with all the cherries and sandy tannins you'd expect, plus structure and blackcurrants from cabernet and a few good licks of chocolate and vanilla from judicious oak use. Full-bodied and harmonic, structured with enticing, and velvet softness. Elegant final sensation*
- 16. Villa Mongalli Le Grazie Montefalco Rosso 2017 (Umbria, 14%)** **\$118**
- *Sangiovese 60%, Sagrantino 15%, Merlot 15%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, (Vivino Rating: 4.2)*
 - *Intense red ruby colour, with tendency to garnet red colour, with fruity parfum and smell of spices and blackberry, harmonious and properly tannic.*
- 17. Villa Cerna Chianti Classico DOCG Riserva 2018 (Toscana, 14%)** **\$128**
- *Sangiovese 95%, Colorino 5%*
 - *This is salty and savory on the nose, with tar, rocks and algae but also sour cherry and sour plum. The palate adds cocoa and coffee grounds alongside riper fruit notes and astringent, gritty tannins.*
- 18. Toscana I.G.T Rosso "SuperTuscan" Commendator Enrico 2019 (Toscana, 15%)** **\$128**
- *50% Sangiovese, 25% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon. (Vivino Rating: 3.9)*
 - *Very intense and concentrated ruby red color. The nose is impressive for the bouquet of ripe fruit among which the raspberry stands out. There is an attractive alternation with balsamic hints of fresh mint and myrtle, refined spicy notes of turmeric and cinnamon complete the bouquet. On the palate it has an elegant tannic texture finely integrated with the freshness. A combination that gives an extraordinarily long finish*

19. Villa Matta Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG 2020 (Veneto, 14.5%) **\$138**

- 70% corvina veronese, 20% rondinella, 5% molinara, 5% others
- An opulent wine of the classic Verona tradition. Red ruby color with garnet highlights. Very fruity with hints of cherry, black cherry and wild berry fruit. The mouth has a good structure with juicy fruit derived from the maceration on skins of Amarone. The tannin is soft and velvety

20. Cantina di Custoza Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico DOCG 2020 (Veneto, 15.5%) **\$158**

- *Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella*
- Garnet red color, intense and bright. Intense cherry, currant, chocolate and spices. Very structured, full, soft, elegant and perfectly balanced

21. Tenuta Di Sesta Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 2020 (Toscana, 14.5%) **\$150**

- *100% Sangiovese (Grosso)*
- *Colour ruby red towards garnet with ageing. Scent intense, broad bouquet, elegant, rich in scents of mellow red fruits, spicy in notes of licorice and tobacco. Taste dry, warm, soft with velvet tannins, balanced, very intense, very persistent and elegant*

RED WINES from FRANCE (Vintage subject to change)

22. Château Hauts de Granget Saint-Emilion Grand Cru 2019 (Bordeaux, 13.5%) **\$128**

- *85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Franc (Vivino Rating: 3.9)*
- *Deep maroon/garnet red in colour with aroma of rich plums, blackcurrants, leather, and spices (pepper, licorice). On the Palate it is round and savory, with notes of dark chocolate and toast from oak integration. Medium-bodied structured with polished, smooth tannins and a refined finish.*

23. Pierre Naigeon Vieilles Vignes Fixin L'Olivier 2018 (Côte De Nuits, Burgundy 13.5%) **\$158**

- *100% Pinot Noir*
- *Bright red-currant notes appear first but get subsumed into a darker, riper notion of blackberry. The palate comes in with that same notion of crushed berry and heightened freshness. All this plays on a sinuous palate that is slightly roughened up by firm tannins. Freshness makes everything alive and lends energy and elegance.*

24. Chateau La Tour de Mons - Margaux red 2014 (Bordeaux, 14%) **\$158**

- *55% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot*
- *A classic wine, elegant and pure and fully respectful of this great terroir of Margaux. Matures for 12 months in French oak barrels. With an intense colour, the wine displays a very broad aromatic range. Elegant and distinguished. This vintage, with its great balance between fruit and tannins. It is a ripe wine full of black fruit and with the bright acidity of the vintage*

25. Château Tour Haut Vignoble Saint-Estèphe 2016 (Bordeaux, 13.5%) **\$138**

- *55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 5% Petite Verdot. (Vivino Rating: 4.1)*
- *A commanding left bank Bordeaux, aged into an unbelievable drinking window. A very powerful wine that delivers blackcurrant fruit, spice and strong tannin in great harmony. There is a silkiness to this wine that is the source of its elegance. The finish is smooth and lingering.*

26. Château du Moulin Noir Lussac-Saint-Émilion 2011 (Bordeaux, 14%) **\$138**

- *70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. (Vivino Rating: 4.1)*
- *This notably complex right bank blend from a satellite appellation of Saint-Emilion offers appealing savoury notes along with a mineral, iron component and liquorice spice. The oak treatment is wonderfully integrated with wood spice elevating the bright red fruit. Harmoniously matured, graceful and very elegant. It offers a silky texture with firm, integrated tannins and a savory, earthy finish.*
